"Mein Vater hat mir alles über das Schnitzen beigebracht: wie man die Werkzeuge handhabt, welches Holz und welche Farben man benutzt. Er war der letzte große Murrungumirri (Paddy Freddy)." (Patrick Freddy Puruntatameri)

Patrick fing mit der Malerei bei Jilamara Arts an, als er mit 17 Jahren die Schule verließ. Er sagt, dass er schon immer Künstler werden wollte, da er von seinem Vater Paddy Freddy Puruntatameri gelernt hatte, einem hochverehrten und anerkannten Schnitzer.

Paddy brachte dem jungen Patrick „dieses und jenes“ bei. Er zeichnete für ihn, lehrte ihn, wie man Hammer und Meißel richtig nutzt, und zeigte ihm die Hölzer, die für Speere und die Schnitzerei geeignet sind. Paddy unterrichtete Patrick auch in der richtigen Farbwahl für die Malerei, etwa wie man Rot herstellt bzw. wo man es findet.

Wenn Patrick eine Pause vom Schnitzen braucht, malt er auf Leinwand und Rinde und schnitzt kleine Speere. Er arbeitet bei seinen Gemälden und beim Schnitzen mit traditionellen Motiven und gilt als innovativer Schnitzer mit hochentwickeltem Geschick und Verstand. Als Motiv wählt er gerne sein Totem: jurukukuni - die Eule.

Er ist verantwortlich für den Jilamara-Schnitz-Workshop, der nach seinem Vater benannt worden ist und gilt als Mentor für jüngere Künstler, die die traditionelle Tiwi-Schnitzkunst und jilamara (Designs der Körpermalerei) erlernen möchten.
