"Ich werde ein Bild mit in den Himmel nehmen, damit mich meine Mutter erkennen kann." (Timothy Cook)

Timothy drückt sich durch seine freien, gestischen, weiten Designs aus. Er malt ausschließlich mit natürlichen Erdpigmenten und gestaltet seine Gemälde instinktsicher und ohne zu zögern. Seine Werke erfreuen sich sowohl in Australien als auch international einer großen Nachfrage für bedeutende Sammlungen. Er gewann im Jahre 2012 den 1. Platz beim prestigeträchtigen National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Art Award.

Seit 1999 erschafft Timothy bei Jilamara Arts Gemälde, Drucke und Schnitzereien, und seine Kunst ist für ihn etwas sehr Persönliches; er liebt die alten Designs, die er von seinen Ältesten gelernt hat. Besonders mag er Punkte (pwanga) als Elemente seiner Darstellungen; diese „Dots“ sind seine "Lieblingsspezialität", weil sein Gesicht bei Zeremonien mit Punkten aus Ocker bemalt wird. Die Dots werden dann von seinen Bunji aufgetragen – ein Verwandtschaftsbegriff, der Kumpel, aber auch Angeheirateter bedeutet.

In den letzten Jahren hat sich Timothy auf das Kulama-Design konzentriert. Die Kulama-Zeremonie ist ein traditioneller Initiationsritus für junge Männer, der mit der Ernte einer bestimmten wilden Yamsart zusammenfällt und in der Regenzeit (März bis April) stattfindet, wenn um den Mond ein Ring erscheint. Die Ältesten beider Geschlechter singen und tanzen drei Tage lang, um die Jungen im Erwachsenendasein willkommen zu heißen. Der junge Mann erhält dann seinen wahren Männernamen.

Die Kreise in diesem Werk symbolisieren den Mond, den Yams und die rituellen Kreise der Kulama-Zeremonie; das Kreuz spiegelt sein (zweites) spirituelles Leben wider, pwanga (Punkte) stellen japalinga (Sterne) dar.

Einige von Timothy's Gemälden repräsentieren auch Taparra (der Mond-Mann), eine bedeutende Figur der Tiwi-Schöpfungsgeschichte.
