Candy wurde 1964 in Yuendumu geboren und ist die Tochter des berühmten Papunya-Künstlers Johnny Warangkula. Dieser brachte seinen Kindern das Malen bei, während er ihnen die Schöpfungsgeschichten der Familie weitergab. Sie alle malen die Regen- und Hagelzeremonie der Kalipynpa- (Wasser-) Schöpfungsgeschichte, die vor allem Candy stetig neu erforscht und malerisch neu erfindet.

Candy hat einen unverwechselbaren, sich weiterentwickelnden Stil. Sie benutzt kühn kontrastierende Farben, schichtet Tropfen, Zeichnungen und Skizzierungen übereinander, um elegante, sehr nachgefragte Werke zu erschaffen, von denen sie sagt: "mit den hervorstechenden zeichnerischen Elementen sehen sie aus, als ob sie atmen würden". Candy zeigt tali (Sandhügel) und fließendes Wasser im Bildhintergrund und benutzt die Dot-Technik um Hagelstürme und Regen darzustellen.
