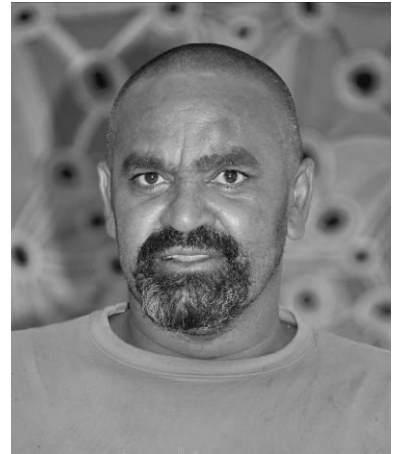


ROBERT FIELDING

Roberts Mutter Garieva Fielding (verstorben) stammt aus einer Beziehung eines Afghanen mit einer Western Arrernte aus South Australia. Sein Vater Bruce Fielding (verstorben) war ein Yankunytjatjara-Mann aus Aputula (Finke). Er wurde in Lilla Creek geboren, wurde aber als Kind seiner Mutter weggenommen und ist im Colebrook Home in Quorn in South Australia aufgewachsen. Roberts Großmutter Miriam Khan (verstorben) kam aus Henbury Station und ihr Ehemann James Inkamala aus Ntaria (Hermannsburg). Robert war der jüngste von zwölf Kindern. Mit neun Kindern – Zaachariaha, Zaavan, Zibeon, Zeldon, Payrozza, Partimah, Peshwah, Priayangka und Zedekiaha Fielding – führt er mit seiner Frau Kaye Lowah die Tradition einer Großfamilie weiter. Kaye kommt ursprünglich von den Torres Strait Inseln (Kanaka).

Seit dem Jahr 2005 entwickelt Robert seine künstlerische Praxis bei Mimili Maku Arts. Seit dem Jahr 2010 ist er als Assistent im Atelier angestellt und unterstützt seine Künstlerkollegen im Kunstzentrum. Robert nahm im Jahr 2013 an dem Programm „Indigenous Arts Leadership“ teil, das von Wesfarmers Arts und der National Gallery of Australia aufgelegt wird, und bahnte daraufhin den Weg für das Arts Worker Programm bei Mimili Maku Arts. In seiner Funktion als Arts Worker entwickelte Robert seine Fähigkeiten in der Fotografie, die er mit Leidenschaft in seine künstlerische Arbeit integriert.
