Susan Wanji Wanji, im Jahre 2013 Finalistin des Telstra National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Art Award, wuchs in Maningrida auf. Als junges Mädchen lernte sie, Rindengemälde sowie aufwändig gewebte Matten und Körbe herzustellen. Sie ist außerordentlich begabt im Weben und im Herstellen von Tunga (Rindenkörbe). Susan begann im Jahre 1990 für Munupi Arts (Yikikinni Women's Centre) zu arbeiten und hat seither einen einzigartigen Stil entwickelt, der Einflüsse aus der Kultur der Tiwi und aus dem Arnhemland vereint.

Im Jahre 1992 reiste Susan nach Paris, um Munupi Arts zu repräsentieren und bei der Hängung einer Ausstellung des Art Centres zu assistieren. Susan arbeitet mit natürlichen Erdpigmenten auf Leinen und Arches Papier und fertigt Linoldrucke und Radierungen. Ihre Werke sind in zahlreichen Sammlungen in Australien und in Übersee vertreten.
